

1. Lisa is putting away the pencils. Each packet holds 10 pencils. Lisa has 86 pencils to put away. How many packets will she need?
2. There are 2 wheels on one bike and 10 wheels on one lorry. There are 6 bikes and 3 lorries in a car park. How many wheels will there be on all the vehicles?
3. Daisy has 60 books. She gives half of them away. Then 2 of her friends give her 2 books each for her birthday. How many books does she have now?
4. There are 40 goldfish in a pond. A heron eats a quarter of them. The pond keeper decides to put 2 more bags of fish in the pond. Each bag has 5 fish in it. How many fish are in the pond now?

Extension Questions -

11. Eddie collects Pokémon cards. There are 5 in a packet. He buys 10 packets. He then swops 5 of his cards for each shiny one. He now has 2 shiny cards. What is the total number of cards Eddie has after he has swapped them?
12. Lucy has 10 packets of crayons. Each packet holds 10 crayons. She has to share them between 5 crayon pots. How many crayons will be in each pot?
