<p>9 Build a den Find some blankets or towels and create your den. Snuggle up and read your favourite book.</p>	<p>10 Video Make a video of something you love. Tell us why you love it.</p>	<p>11 Drawing Draw a picture of something you love or your favourite ...</p>	<p>12 Obstacle course Build your own obstacle course. How fast can you complete it?</p>
<p>13 Story bag Find a bag and collect items/toys to make up your own story or that go with a known story. If you can't find an item then draw a picture of it.</p>	<p>14 Draw a map Create a map of your house/garden. Label interesting things on it. Look at the local area on google earth. Draw a map of it and highlight interesting landmarks.</p>	<p>15 Write a postcard or a letter Tell the person you are writing to what you have been doing today.</p>	<p>16 Draw a view Look out each window and draw what you can see. How many windows have you got? Can you see the same thing out each window or is the view different?</p>
<p>17 Junk Modelling Collect and recycle materials such as yoghurt pots, toilet rolls and boxes and see what you can create with them. Take a photo; make a video describing what you have created!</p>	<p>18 Weather diary Look out the window each day and make a note of the weather. Does it change each day? Draw it or take a photo. Pretend to be a weather reporter and make a video of yourself giving a weather report.</p>	<p>19 Observational drawing Find your favourite toy and draw a picture of it. What else could you find to draw around the house? It could be a picture of a person, place or object.</p>	<p>20 Nature diary Look out the window each day and keep a note of what you can see. Birds, flowers, what else? Draw it or take a photo. How does it change each day? What is growing? What animals visit and why do they visit?</p>
