

## Funky Fingers activities to do at home

### 1 Dough gym

Try this youtube dough gym video. If you don't have any playdough you could use blu-tac or even just pretend.

### 2 Colouring in

If you have a colouring book at home try some colouring in. Can you stay inside the lines?

### 3 Dot-to-dot

Dot-to-dot will help with number recognition as well as pencil control.

### 4 Tracing

You could trace a picture you have printed from the computer, or a page from a colouring book.

### 5 Egg box sorting

Can children sort small objects into egg boxes as shown below?

The smaller the object the more challenging it will be!



### 6 Cutting

Can children cut along a straight line? How about a zigzag line? Can they cut out a shape?

This activity will need supervision.

### 7 Colander threading

Can children thread pipecleaners, string or spaghetti through the holes in a colander?



### 8 Mazes
