

# EYFS Remote Learning Package @ CHIS



**In the event** that your child can't attend school due to the Government's current decision regarding Covid isolation, the school has measures in place so that learning can continue away from the classroom.

The package that we have developed is age and stage appropriate for young children and uses a variety of platforms that we already use in school.

If your child needs to engage in remote learning, we do not expect them to work all day. The guidance is that KS1 children work for 3 hours and we suggest this is broken up with down time, play time, getting fresh air and doing practical activities.

## **PING**

We will be using PING, our communication app to send you the learning each week. You will most likely want to view this content on something larger than a phone, and PING allows you to log in online using your username and password. The PING will contain everything you will need to complete that week. This learning will take a variety of forms including phonics and mathematics

activities as well as links to stories, videos and learning activities linked to other areas of the early years curriculum.

## **Tapestry**

We are also going to use Tapestry, our online learning journal, as a way for you to share your remote learning with teachers.

Each week there will be one activity that we would like you to upload to Tapestry for feedback; **this will be highlighted in yellow.** This will be in a variety of subjects depending on what is being taught that week. Teachers will provide individual feedback on these specific activities. You are welcome to continue uploading other learning moments to Tapestry to share with your child's teacher. Teachers may make comments on these posts but will only provide more specific feedback for the highlighted activity.

## **BUG CLUB**

As usual we will still make full use of Bug Club, and coloured level books are allocated to your child's account for them to read, especially at any time away from school when it's not possible to change reading books.

## **WEBSITE**

All learning content and a variety of other useful resources and links will remain on our website in the 'Children' - 'Home Learning' section should you wish to dip into these activities.

## **WHAT WILL HAPPEN?**

In the event your child needs to isolate, we will PING you with the details of the remote learning that week. The activity we would like you to upload to Tapestry will be highlighted. We will send each week's new remote learning on Fridays for the duration of the time that your child is away from school. Please note that this remote learning is only expected if your child is well. Should there be partial or full school closures we will begin the remote

learning process, and then you will receive new PINGs on Fridays thereafter.

## WHAT YOU WILL NEED

- In order to access the home learning you will need a device, such as a phone, tablet or PC. You will need to be signed up to PING, but ideally access it online, rather than through the app as it will be easier to see. We will try to make sure that all activities sent home can be done without having to print resources
- You will need to know log in details for Tapestry and Bug Club
- Children will need at least a pencil and some paper to write on

## HOW TO ACCESS PING:

- Ensure app is installed on your phone or device (the screen will be small with this option)
- Ideally access PING online through a larger device or PC. Click the link and sign in using your username and password. Your home learning overview will be in your message stream and you will then be able to click on all of the links.

## HOW TO ACCESS TAPESTRY:

- You can access Tapestry via the app. Ensure the app is installed on your phone or device. You can sign in using your 4-6 digit code which you should have created when you signed up to Tapestry.
- You can also sign in to Tapestry through a PC. Click the link to the Tapestry website and sign in using your email address and password.

## HOW TO ACCESS BUG CLUB:

- Access Bug Club in the usual way or click the link below

- Sign in using your child's username and password
