-The colours denote a change in focus/activity and a possible suggestion of how to break up the day

-It might help to agree the day's activities in the morning and decide when breaks and reward times will be

-Decide on quiet time activities and games in the morning too. These will all act as incentives to get the work done

-Use 'first' and 'then' activities so children know what is coming. It helps if 'then' is a reward or treat activity

-Build in as much off screen time as possible, especially if you want to reward working hard or post 'school day' treats with screen time

-If the approach isn't working, try something new or have a 10 minute break and try again

-Parents and carers have permission to reward housepoints! Keep a tally of how many they collect!
