We use this technique to help students when sharing ideas and when initially performing in front of their peers. This idea is further developed through vocal exercises, scripts and ensemble singing. Students benefit from this approach as it helps to ensure the group bonds well. We aim to create a safe space where children can feel free to be creative which instils the value of learning through play. We then develop the notion of learning through play using Drama, Voice and Drama games.
