I am writing to let you know about two online subscriptions we provide for children called Oxford Owl and Purple Mash.



Oxford Owl

Oxford Owl is an online library where children can access:

- Homework - Children will be set books to read at home
- Oxford Owl e-library - Books for parents/carers to read to their children
- RWI (Read, Write Inc) eBook Library - This will store the books that you have been allocated as homework and keep a record of what you have read.
- eBooks Selection - A range of RWI books (please note these will be from all colour levels and not just the level your child is on)

Teachers will update your child's 'Homework' according to their colour level. **Please note that there are no Lilac books for us to allocate.** If your child is on Lilac level reading books, you can enjoy sharing books from the oxford owl e-library and continue to practise phonics using the sound cards sent home by teachers.

Purple Mash

Purple Mash is primarily used in Year 1 and Year 2. There are a range of games, activities and videos linked to different areas of the Key Stage 1 curriculum.
