Nursery

Stories: Flashing Fire Engines

Number songs/Stories: 5 cheeky monkeys

Other Areas: We are very excited for Thursday afternoon, when we'll be joined by some very special guests- the local firefighters! They're bringing their fire engine along to show us all the fascinating equipment they use to keep us safe. Back in the classroom, we will be diving into firefighter stories and getting creative by making their very own fire engines. For our school leavers, we're sharpening our ears in Phonics by matching sounds to objects and actions. They'll also be getting hands-on during Story Dough, sculpting fire engines complete with ladders and sirens.

Finally, we'll be putting our thinking caps on in Maths as we practice our counting and master the concept of "adding 1 more."

Phonics: We will be using our phonic knowledge to read the red books 'pick it up' and 'wuff wuff'.

Maths: We will be learning about the composition of 5 next week. We will focus on learning all the different ways we can make 5 and asking how many more do we need to make 5?

Reception

Other Areas: Next week, we are diving into the classic story Peepo! We'll be playing "history detectives" by looking closely at the illustrations to spot how homes from the past differ from our own today.

In addition, we will begin exploring internet safety, using stories to learn how to use technology sensibly and securely. Our PSED (Personal, Social, and Emotional Development) theme is all about sharing. We'll be reading Sharing a Shell and Ping Won't Share to help us practice being kind and thoughtful classmates.

Year 1

Phonics: Revising previously taught special friends and sounds

Maths: Assessment of number bonds and odd and even numbers

Foundation subjects: In Science we will be naming the external body parts of animals and noticing what is the same (head, leg, foot) and what is different (wing, beak, tail) compared to humans. In History we will be deepening our knowledge about schools in the Victorian era and completing a sorting activity to show our understanding that schools today and in the past have both similarities and differences. For Art we shall be looking at the artwork of Quentin Blake and comparing it to the work of Beatrix Potter and in DT we will be following our designs to make our own sliders - how exciting! In Computing we will begin to learn how to debug a program and in RE we will learn about the Prophet Muhammad from the Islamic faith. In PE we will continue to practise our throwing and catching skills and use them to play simple games and in Music we will revisit 'tempo' - an action packed week for us, for sure!




Year 2

Phonics/GPS: Assessment of spelling rules taught this term

Maths: Mass; comparing grams and kilograms

Foundation subjects: This week in Science, we will be working outdoors to investigate the materials used in our school building and playground, considering their suitability and purpose. In Art, we continue exploring line and shape by carefully copying photographs of 17th-century buildings, using black biro only. Our Online Safety lesson focuses on online bullying. We will discuss what bullying is and how anyone experiencing it can get help from trusted adults, such as parents, teachers, or leaders (for example, cub leaders, dance teachers, or football coaches). In DT, we begin our exciting ongoing project: constructing our own fire engines. Children will use a range of tools and equipment, including saws, to fix a wheel and axle mechanism to their models. In History, we will use a variety of sources to answer the key question: Why did the Great Fire of London spread so quickly? During Gymnastics, children will apply the skills they have been learning to perform gymnastic movements and link them together into a sequence. Finally, in RE, we continue learning about sacred texts. This week, we will explore the Qur'an, the sacred text of Muslims.

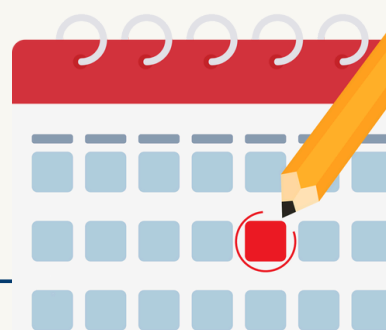
